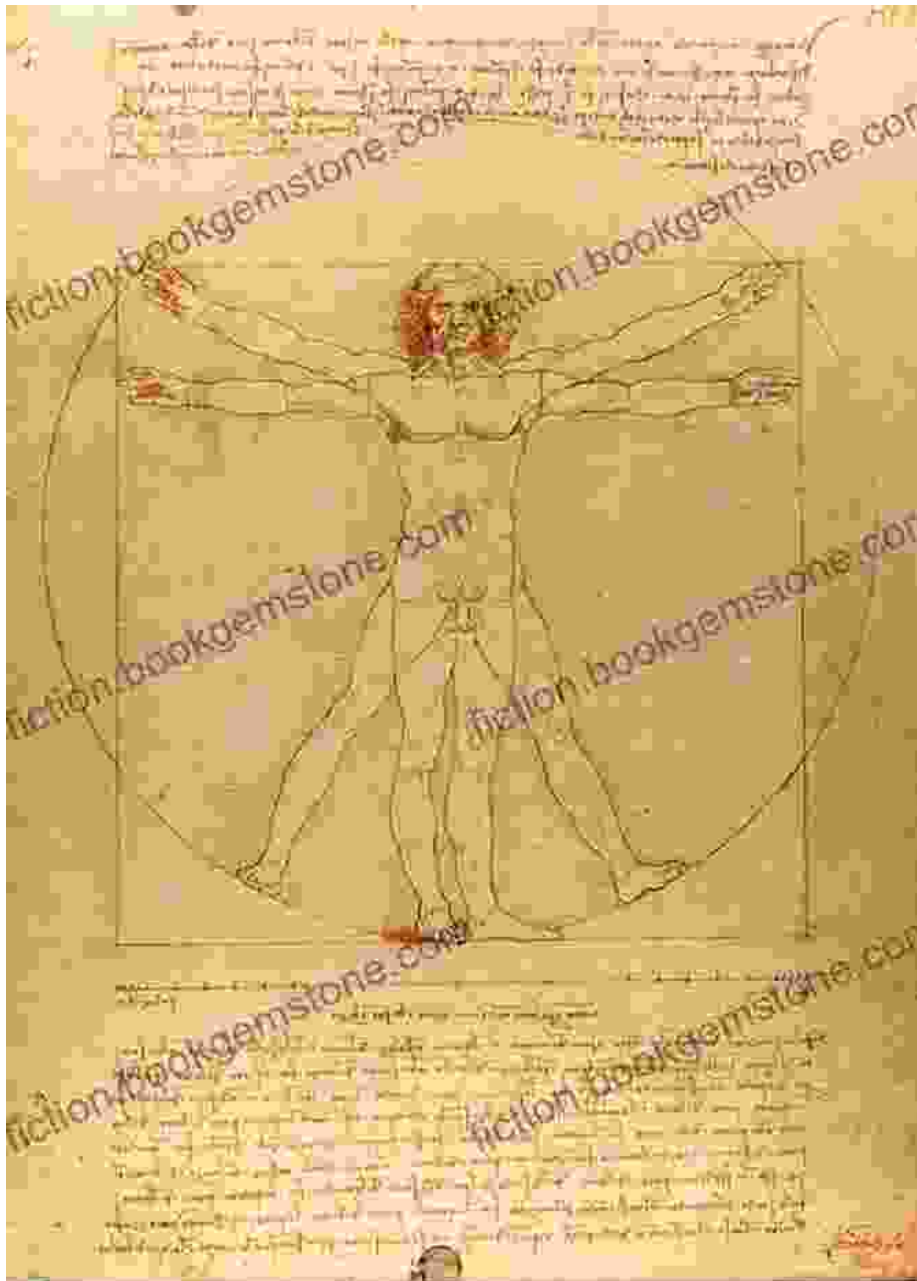

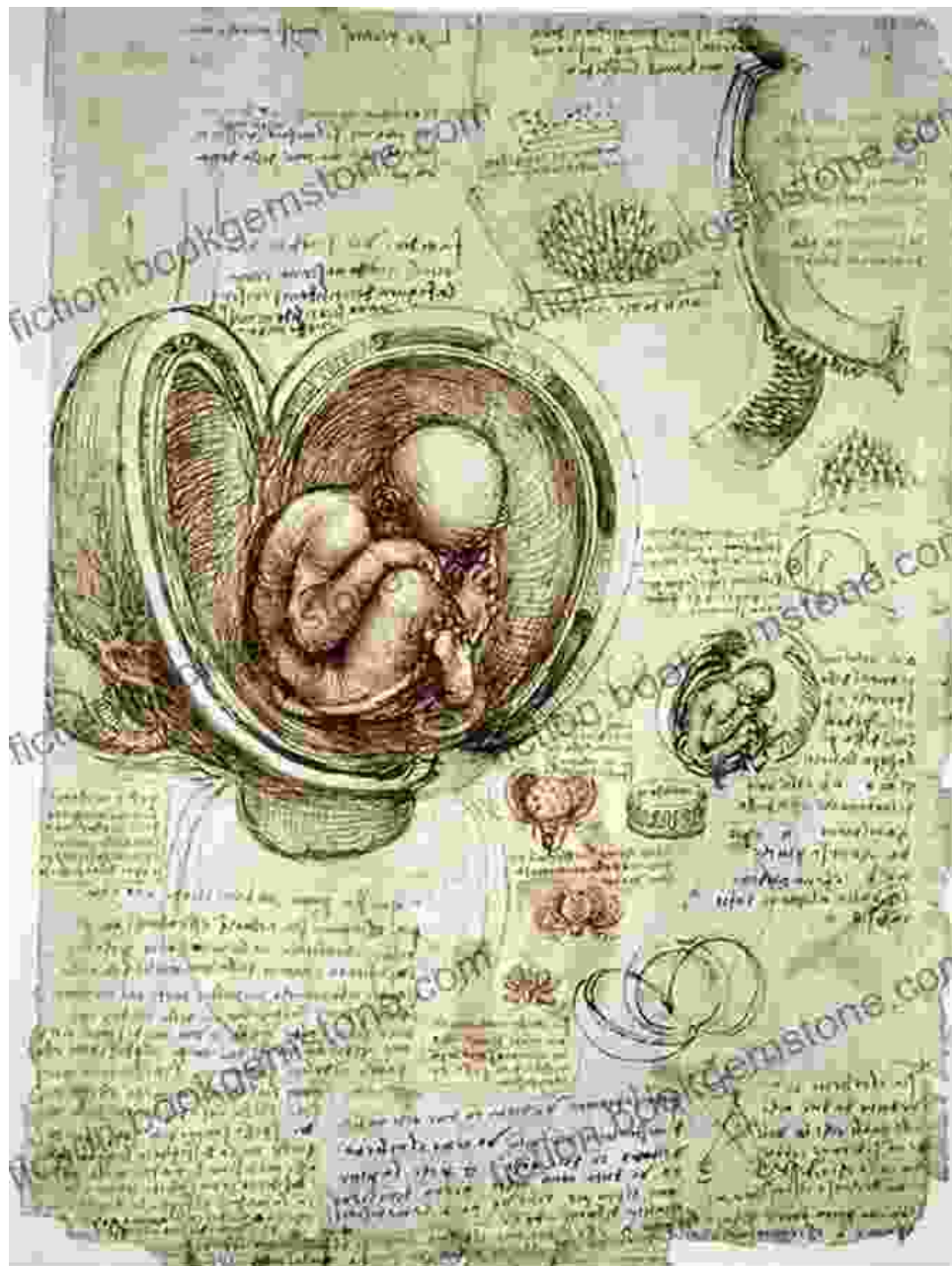

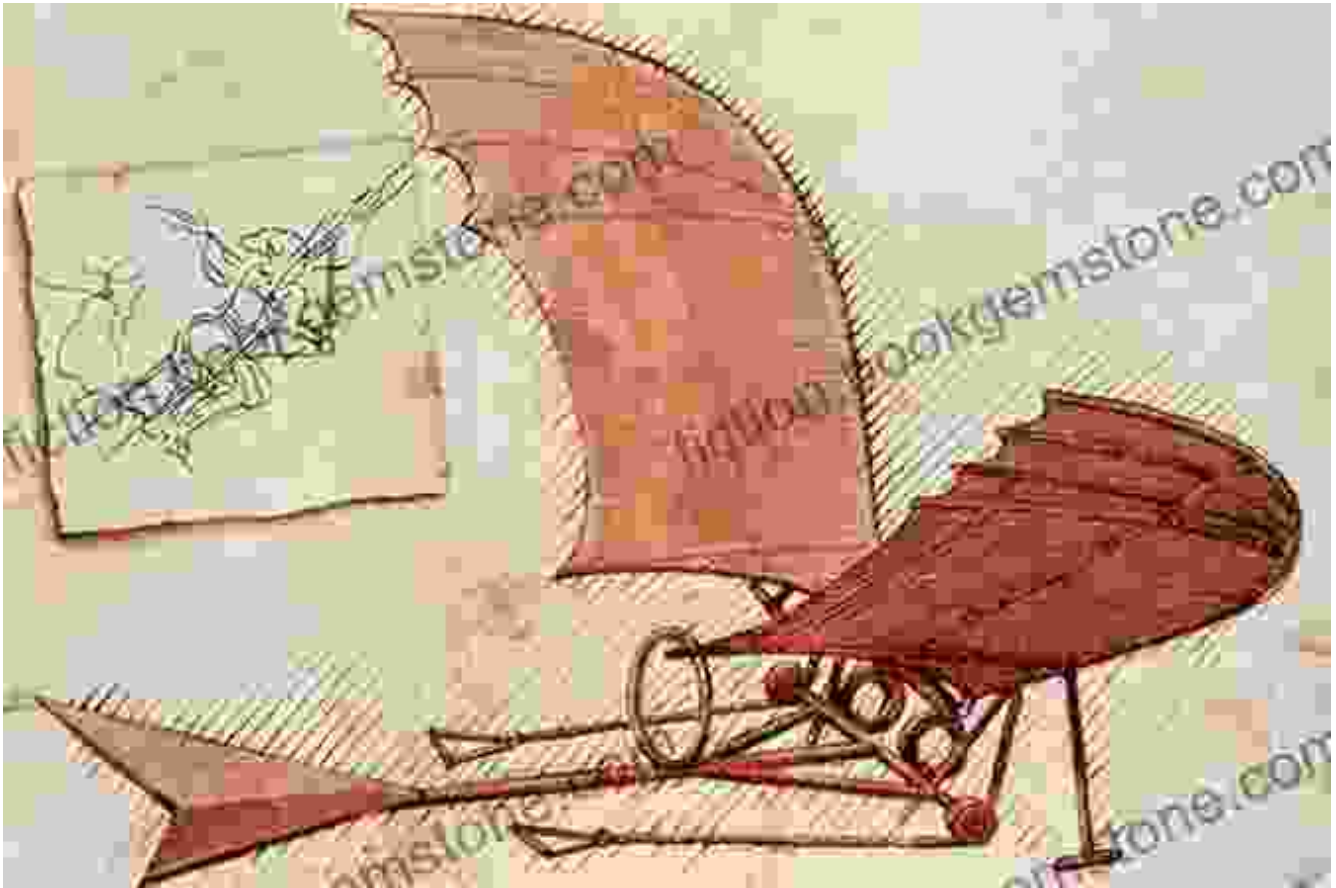


Anatomical studies, c. 1510-1515. Codice Atlanticus, Biblioteca Ambrosiana, Milan.

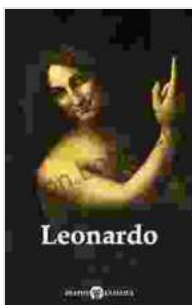

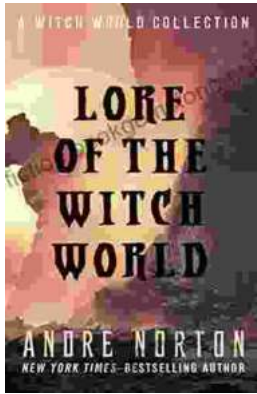

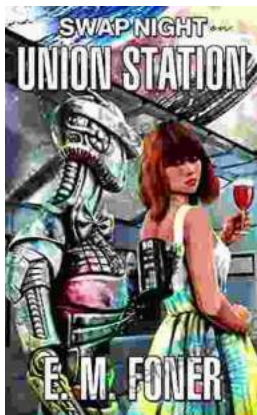
