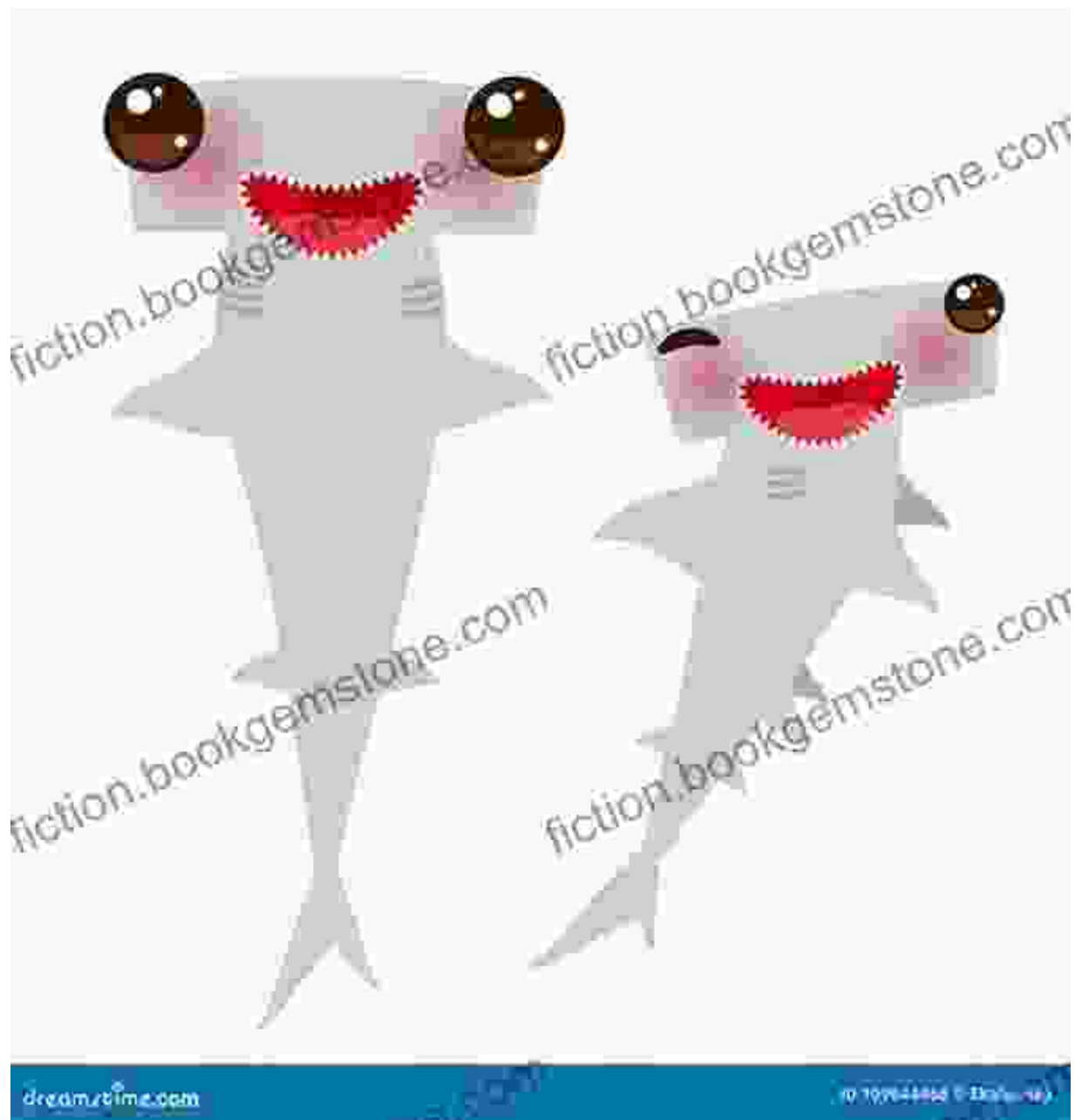

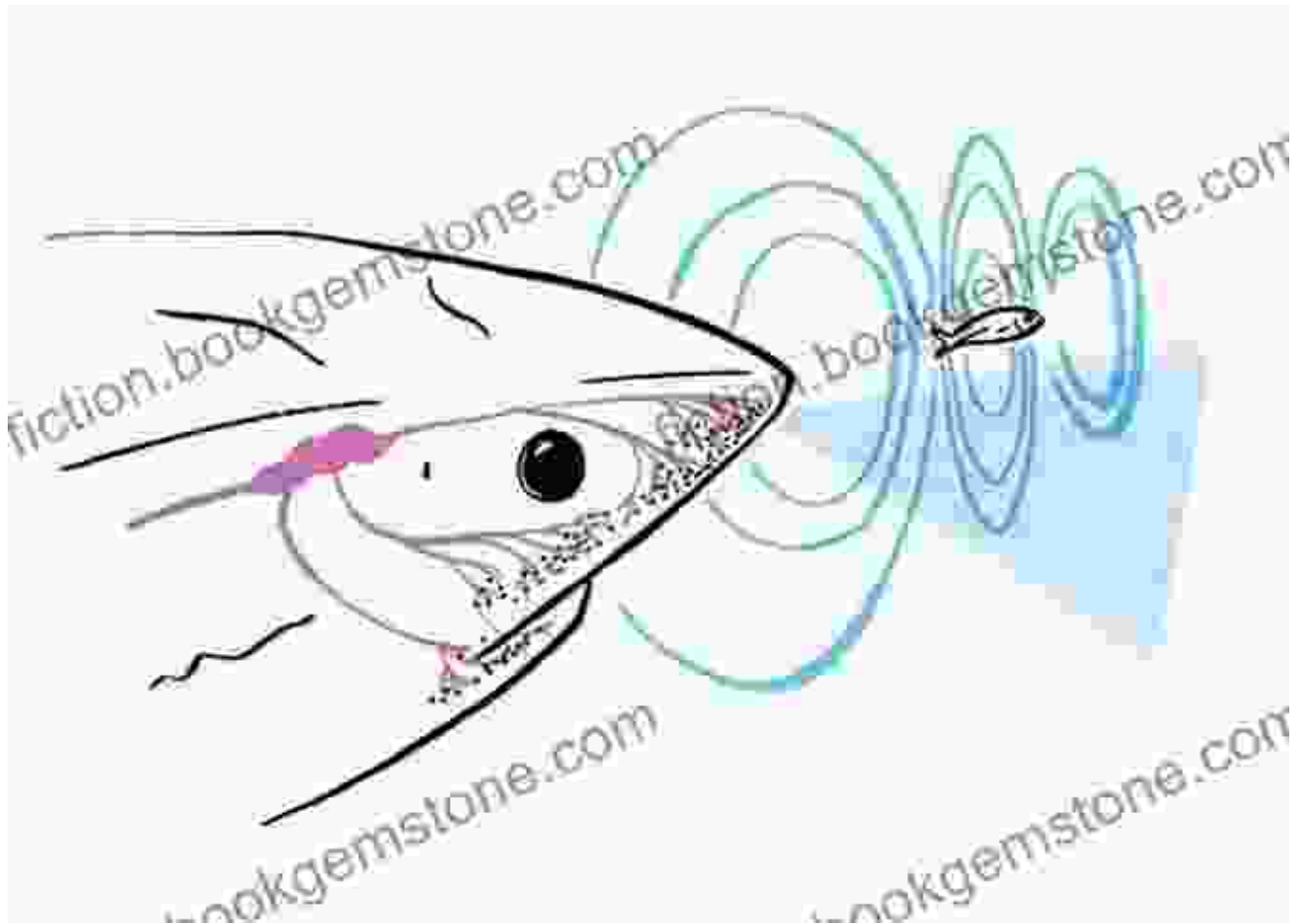


1. Sharks Can Wink

6. Sharks Can't Blink



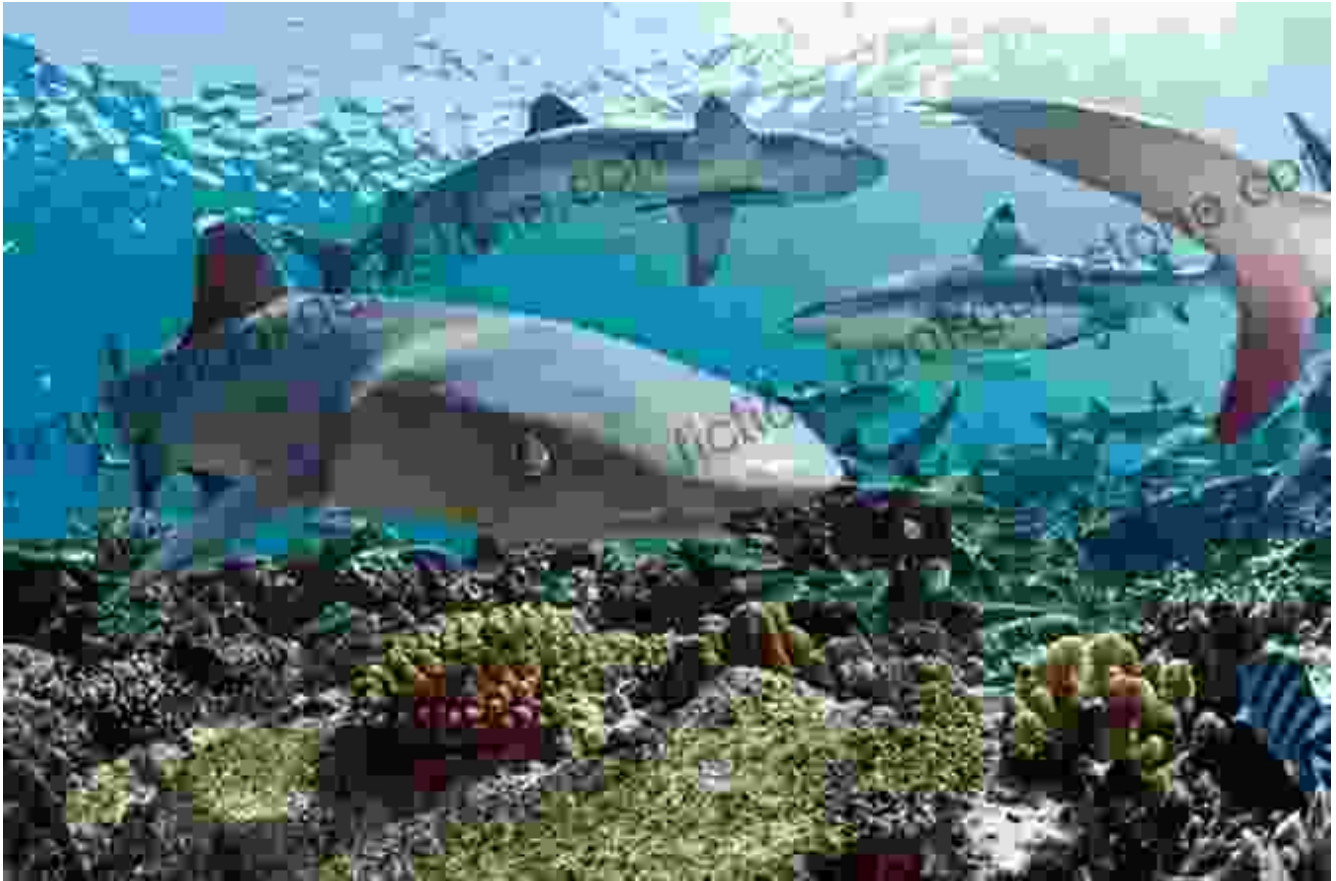

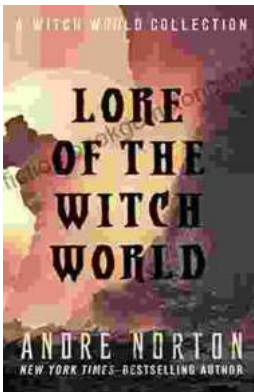
