Macrame Plant Hanger

Difficulty: Beginner

Materials: Macrame cord, scissors, measuring tape

DIY Candles

Woven Wall Hanging

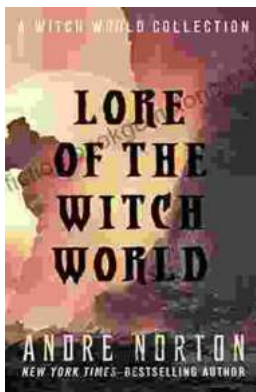

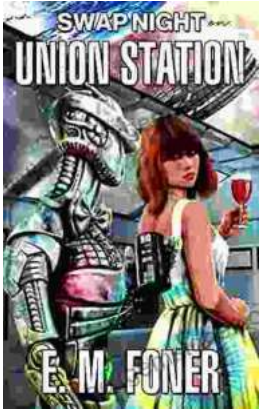
